Each year staff have to complete an array of mandatory training. This includes CPR and anaphylaxis training that Lue Public organises with Surf Lifesaving. We have excellent trainers. This year it was pointed out that small schools would be an excellent venue to house an Automated External Defribulator. Goolma public has provided this for our community.
