Enjoy your Easter Break and I look forward to seeing you all next Term!






HENRY GREAT FROSTBITE CHASE


Narrative Journey



For the last few weeks of this term we have been focusing on narrative journeys. Our two focus texts were A Bag and A Bird by Pamela Allen and The Great Rabbit Chase by

Freya Blackwood. These texts were used to investigate how students can make their writing more interesting by using noun groups, verb groups, adjectives, and prepositional

phrases. To complete the unit of work the students had to plan a journey around the school that their character would follow before writing their narrative.
