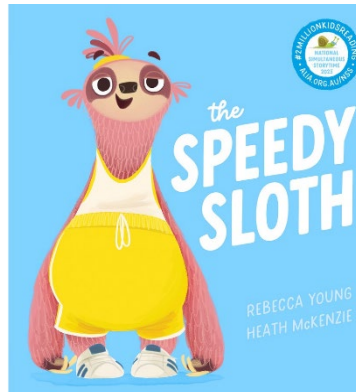
Our Year 4 students sat their final Check-In assessment this week. We look forward to seeing their results.
